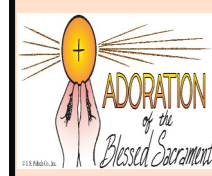
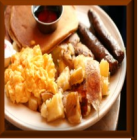

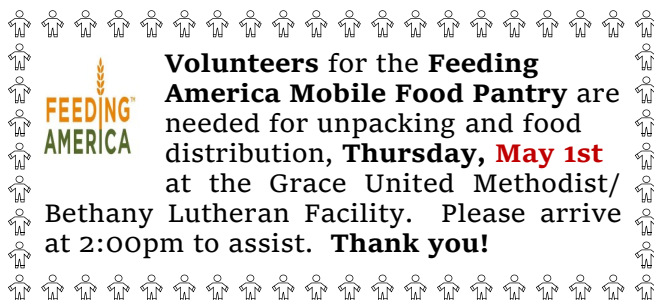
Hummels For Sale/eBay or Online Auction help needed
