



HOLY WEEK / EASTER TRIDUUM




Tuesday, April 15th: Mass will be celebrated at 5:00 p.m. at Saint Mary Parish.

The Triduum, the great three days, is the climax of the Liturgical year and the central Christian mystery of the triumph of life over death. The 40 days of Lent have been leading us to the three days where Christians gather to celebrate the mystery of the passion, death and resurrection of Jesus. With prayer and dramatic ritual we move into Easter, coming forward to place our hand in the baptismal waters and renew our response to the Lord. Please join us for our liturgies on Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil on April 17th, 18th and 19th.

Holy Thursday, April 17th: Mass at 7:00 p.m. at Saint Barbara Parish, On Holy Thursday the Church



celebrates the institution of the Holy Eucharist and the priesthood. "This is my body, which will be given for you; do this in memory of me." (Luke 22:19B) Come celebrate the joy of ministry that is the fabric of service to others. In the washing of



the feet we come to a profound humility rooted in the example of Christ. On this same Holy Thursday night, we celebrate the arrival of the Holy Oils to our community: the Oil of Chrism, the Oil of the Sick and the Oil of Catechumens. After Mass, all remaining hosts are taken to an altar of repose, where Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament occurs.


Good Friday, April 18th: Service at Noon at Saint Mary Parish and 3:00 p.m. at Saint Barbara Parish.
